APRIL 1 - CLINIC #1

The first of three clinics clinic is this Saturday, April 1, at Jerry Stander's Fix Auto, Highlands Ranch, 3900 Norwood Drive, Littleton, CO 80125. Clinic classroom is approximately from 10 to noon and workshop from noon to 2:00 pm.

The topic is "Getting Started Correctly".

This will include proper driver fit and position, building basics, the physics of Soap Box Derby and a general overview of the sport and upcoming races. All are invited. Bring your cars if you would like specific guidance and help. We will be willing to do a pre-inspection at all clinics to help prepare any racers for the June 24th official inspection.

APRIL 15TH CLINIC #2

The second clinic will cover the basics behind setting the alignment to reduce the forces upon the car that affect speed, eliminating cross bind, and weight setup. The workshop will involve actually setting these criteria on your cars in preparation for the next week's rally.

MAY 13 - CLINIC #3

The third clinic will cover the final car adjustments and an in depth look into driving skills that lead to a win. Most importantly, this is your opportunity to have help perfecting the weights, alignment, and triangulation to ensure that they are set and optimally ready for racing for the following week's rally and in preparation for the local championship race in June.
