9:00am – Drivers line up for the parade on Maple Street, between the Court House and the Congregational Church.


9:30am - Parade Starts





Wheel Swap & Lane Change

The All-American Soap Box Derby rules require that we do a "Wheel Swap" and "Lane Change" for every heat. What that means is Racer A and Racer B race in the first heat. Racer A would be in Lane 1 and Racer B would be in Lane 2. Now each Racer and their car are brought back up to the top of the hill and they will race a second time. Before they race for the second time, they will swap their wheels with each other. After the other seven first heats, they will race their second race. This time Racer A will be in Lane 2 and Racer B will be in Lane 1. If one racer wins both races, then that driver is declared the winner. If Racer A wins the first race, and Racer B wins the second race, then the winner will be decided by which racer had the greatest time differential based on the official timer. After the second race, the racers swap their wheels again, so that they get their original wheels back.
