

Greetings from Northwest Indiana Soap Box Derby Committee!! This year will be the 77th running of the NWI Soap Box Derby. We hope that you will be able to join us this year. Here are the dates that will be of interest and importance to all who wish to be involved in this year's race.

On **Tuesday, March 21**st, we will have our annual corporation and public meeting at American Legion Post 94 located at 4 Monroe Street in Valparaiso. An open meeting will be at 7:00 PM for all interested racers and sponsors.

The following car clinics will take place at Old Fairgrounds Park in Valparaiso.

Saturday, April 29th, 9:00-12:00 will be a car clinic

Saturday, May 6th, 9:00-12:00 will be a car clinic and practice

Saturday, May 20th, 9:00-12:00 will be a practice and car tune up

Monday, May 20th is the due date for all racer applications. A complete application (completed registration form, shirt & signage sheet, minor waiver for racer, adult waiver for adult in pits, letter of Akron intent, copy of the racer's birth certificate(if not given to secretary in 2022) and \$150 race fee) will need to be turned in to the metal box labeled NWI Soapbox located in the downstairs area of American Legion Post 94. Please place the completed race application in a sealed envelope before dropping in the box, you will find extra envelopes in the front of the metal box if needed. Please do **NOT** give the applications to any of the American Legion staff, place them in the box yourself!

Saturday, June 17 from 8:00 am -4:00 pm will be final car inspection, weigh-ins and public bracket drawing at VFW Post 98, 705 Roosevelt Road in Valparaiso. Show up **BY** 4:00 PM. A signup genius will be sent to all racer's emails to signup for a inspection time.

June 24, 2023 is Race Day! As is years past, it will be on Lincolnway between Garfield Street and Morgan Street in Valparaiso.

Parent/Guardian Code Of Conduct

The International Soap Box Derby, Inc. has implemented the following Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in racing. Parents MUST read, understand and sign this form prior to their children participating in our races.

I understand that any action inconsistent with this Code of Conduct or any failure to take action mandated by this Code of Conduct may result in my immediate removal from the facility. I also understand that I may be suspended from following events pending a review by the Conduct Committee of the ISBD. Repeat violations may cause forfeiture of the privilege of attending all events. I acknowledge and agree that the Derby has the complete and absolute discretion to make a determination as to this issue and its decision shall be finl and binding. I therefore agree:

- 1. I will not force my child to participate in Soap Box Derby racing.
- 2. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the activity is for youth, not adults.
- 3. I will inform the Race Director of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
- 4. I will learn the rules and policies of the organization.
- 5. I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by deimonstrating positive support for participants, officals and spectators at every race or any related event.
- 6. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any offical, racer, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
- 7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well being of the participants, officals and spect at or s.
- 8. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflits without resorting to lost ility or vidence.
- 9. I will demand that my child treat other participants, officals and spect at α s w th respect regard α s of race, creed, color, sex or ability.

- 10. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a race or his/her performance.
- 11. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
- 12. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 13. I will emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefitm this ld over $\dot{\mathbf{w}}$ ming. I $\dot{\mathbf{w}}$ ll d so de-emphasize races and competition in the lower age groups.
- 14. I will promote the emotional and physical wellbeing of the racers ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
- 15. I will respect the officals and their authority during races and will never question, discuss, or confront others at the race track, and will take time to speak with officals at an agreed upon time and place.
- 16. I will demand an environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all events.
- 17. Iiacknowledge and agree that any decisions of the officals of the Soap Box Dorby shall be firm and binding upon me and my child in all respects and at all times.

INTENT TO RACE IN NATIONALS IN AKRON, OHIO

If your racer wins this local race in Valparaiso, Indiana, they automatically qualify to race in the All-American Soap Box Derby which is held in Akron, Ohio, every year. This year the race week will begin July 16th and will last through Saturday, July 22nd. Your car will have to be dropped off in Akron, Ohio, July 9-15 or could be shipped at your own expense. You will be responsible for the cost of either transportation or shipping to get your winner's car to Akron. The NWI Soap Box Derby will be providing winners with \$500 to help pay for expenses for the Nationals Race Week. In previous years the All-American Soap Derby has made hotel partners to help with the cost of lodging for race week. In 2022, those hotels ranged from \$100-150 per night. What you as a family need to decide now is can or can you not attend?
