

The **BB&T All-American Soap Box Derby** is a Project of the Kiwanis Club of Bowling Green Foundation. This is a fundraiser for the community in which proceeds go to local kid-oriented charities.

SUPER KIDS Division: The Super Kids division is for kids with special needs that cannot race in the other divisions. Racers in this division are paired with a co-pilot (experience driver) from the local race. The co-pilot will have total control of the derby car. Participants must be seven (7) years of age prior to the local race and may not have reached their 19th birthday prior to the national race date (July 15, 2016); and not exceed a personal weight of 185. Racers must have a medically diagnosed disability, which a physician is willing to document. Due to the special needs of each child, parents must be responsible for loading and unload their racer from the cars.



The Kiwanis Club of Bowling Green Foundation has purchased and built four Super Kids cars. We are looking for 8 to 12 special needs children to participant in the Kosair Children's Hospital - Meijer Super Kids Classic in Bowling Green, KY. We will have helmets to use or you can purchase one for \$15. Unlike the other divisions, these derby cars are already built for the kids. The first place winner will have a chance to compete at the Nationals in July.

Check List

- Pick up a 2016 Derby Schedule
- Complete registration forms including birth certificate, Bio sheet, and all Medical forms.
- Registration fee of \$25. This includes racing in the derby, event t-shirt, racer's plaque w/ photo, 2 tickets to the Racers Banquet. Extra shirts and banquet tickets are available for \$10 each.
- Test drive down the track either March 26th or May 14th.

- Check in is May 14th.
