



RACE SAFETY GUIDELINES

Volunteers, Car Handlers, and Racers

- Everyone must maintain six-foot social distancing.
- Avoid congregating in common spaces or parking lot before, during or after event.
- No touch rule is in effect. All individuals must avoid physical contact before, during and after races.
- We recommend all wear face coverings. (Mandatory in Ohio)
- There will be no drivers meeting. All meeting information will be distributed to Racers the week prior via email.
- Car handlers and Racers must wait in their dedicated pit area for their race.
- Limiting attendance to racers and two car handlers per car- one at the bottom and one at top.
- All volunteers, Car Handlers or Racers with a temperature of 100 or higher or other symptoms consistent with COVID should stay home.

Equipment, Vehicles, and Facilities

- Masks, gloves and hand sanitizer will be available.
- Wheel swap will be conducted only by four volunteers who will be wearing gloves. (Two volunteers at starting line and two volunteers in run out.)
- Restrooms will be cleaned every two hours.
- Return vehicle handles will be cleaned between each use by two volunteers as champs exit the vehicle. (one volunteer pit and one at starting line)

Recommendations

- If you can't safely social distance with your field size, we suggest running the races with separate divisions at different times (ie stock in morning, super stock in afternoon)
