The ISBD is currently planning the 83rd FirstEnergy All-American Soap Box Derby (FEAASBD) World Championship Race Week, pending pandemic restrictions.

Below you will find the most recent updates:

- The 83rd FEAASBD World Championship Race Week will be held July 18 - 24, 2021.
 - The Race Week detailed schedule and format are still to be determined.
- The ISBD is reviewing specifics of qualifications for the 83rd FEAASBD World Championship.
- An update to rule B-2. Minimum Participation:
 - The minimum number of participants in Local races to qualify for the All-American for 2021 ONLY includes the following:
 - Minimum of eight (8) Stock.
 - Minimum of eight (8) Super Stock.
 - Minimum of four (4) Masters.
